Pronunciation of Tube Stations

English pronunciation is not simple because of:

- Extra vowel sounds:** *London* [ˈlʌndən], *Borough* [ˈbɒrə], and *Southwark* [ˈsʌðə(r)k] share the same stressed vowel, the *strut* vowel [ʌ], and the same unstressed vowel: the schwa [ə]. The schwa is the most common sound in English, but doesn't have a specific letter and doesn't exist in many other languages.
- Complex Spelling rules:** *Blackwall* [ˈblækwoːl], *Star Lane* [ˈstɔː(r)ˈleɪn], and *Mudchute* [ˈmʌdʃʊt] are not considered difficult to pronounce by native speakers. Why is this the case? It's because of complex yet consistent rules. For instance, the letter <a> is generally pronounced as [a], but shifts depending on what follows—for example, [ɔː] in <all>, [ɑː] in <ar>, and [eɪ] in <a_e>. Similarly, there are two common pronunciations for 'u': [ʌ] and [ʊw] but the sequence <u_e> is invariably pronounced as [ʊw]. Speakers learn these rules through associations with common words spelled similarly, such as: *call* [kɔːl], *car* [kɑː(r)], *case* [keɪs], and *June* [dʒʊn].
- Multiple Exceptions:** Sometimes, even native speakers are not sure of the pronunciation as there are words that don't resemble anything else, such as *South Quay* [ˈsawθ ˈkɪj]. Other times, even more confusingly, they look like something else yet are pronounced differently, like *Greenwich* [ˈɡrɛntʃ] and *Plaistow* [ˈplɑːstəw].
- Disappearing consonants:** Some consonants are always silent, like the <c> in *Leicester Square* [ˈleɪstə(r)ˈskwɜː(r)]. Some are usually pronounced but optionally dropped, especially in fast speech. For example, <t> and <d> at the end of words when the following word starts with a consonant; e.g., *Covent Garden* [ˈkɒv(ə)n(t)ˈɡɑː(r)d(ə)n].
- The 'r' Special Case:** Standard Southern British is a non-rhotic accent, and 'r' is only pronounced if followed by a vowel sound. For example, in *Honor Oak Park* [ˈɒnər əwk ˈpɑː(r)k], the <r> in *Honor* is pronounced, while the <r> in *Park* is not. Nevertheless, these *silent r* sounds are pronounced in many accents, and pronouncing them might make learners more easily understood by others.
- Conclusion:** There is no agreement on the standard pronunciation of *Marylebone*, with many considered correct. However, there is a consensus that [ˈmɜːrɪləbɔːn], though it might seem like the most obvious choice, is certainly incorrect. The chosen pronunciation for the map is [ˈmɑː(r)ləbɔːn], with the weak [w] glide of the unstressed [əw] diphthong possibly barely perceptible.

IPA

The International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) was devised to describe and compare the sounds of all world languages. It has become the global standard for showing pronunciation in dictionaries and educational materials. The IPA uses a mix of familiar yet modified symbols—many of which were originally made by altering existing type, like rotating letters or removing parts, to save on the cost of casting metal in the 19th century. For example, a capital A without a crossbar represents the strut vowel [ʌ], while an upside-down 'e' stands for schwa [ə].

Despite its accuracy, IPA symbols are often misused in dictionaries. Many still include outdated or misleading symbols, such as [æ], [eə(r)], or the so-called "long i" [iː], which is actually a diphthong. Others use entirely made-up symbols like [ɪ]. The IPA system used in this map has been adapted from the CUBE dictionary.
