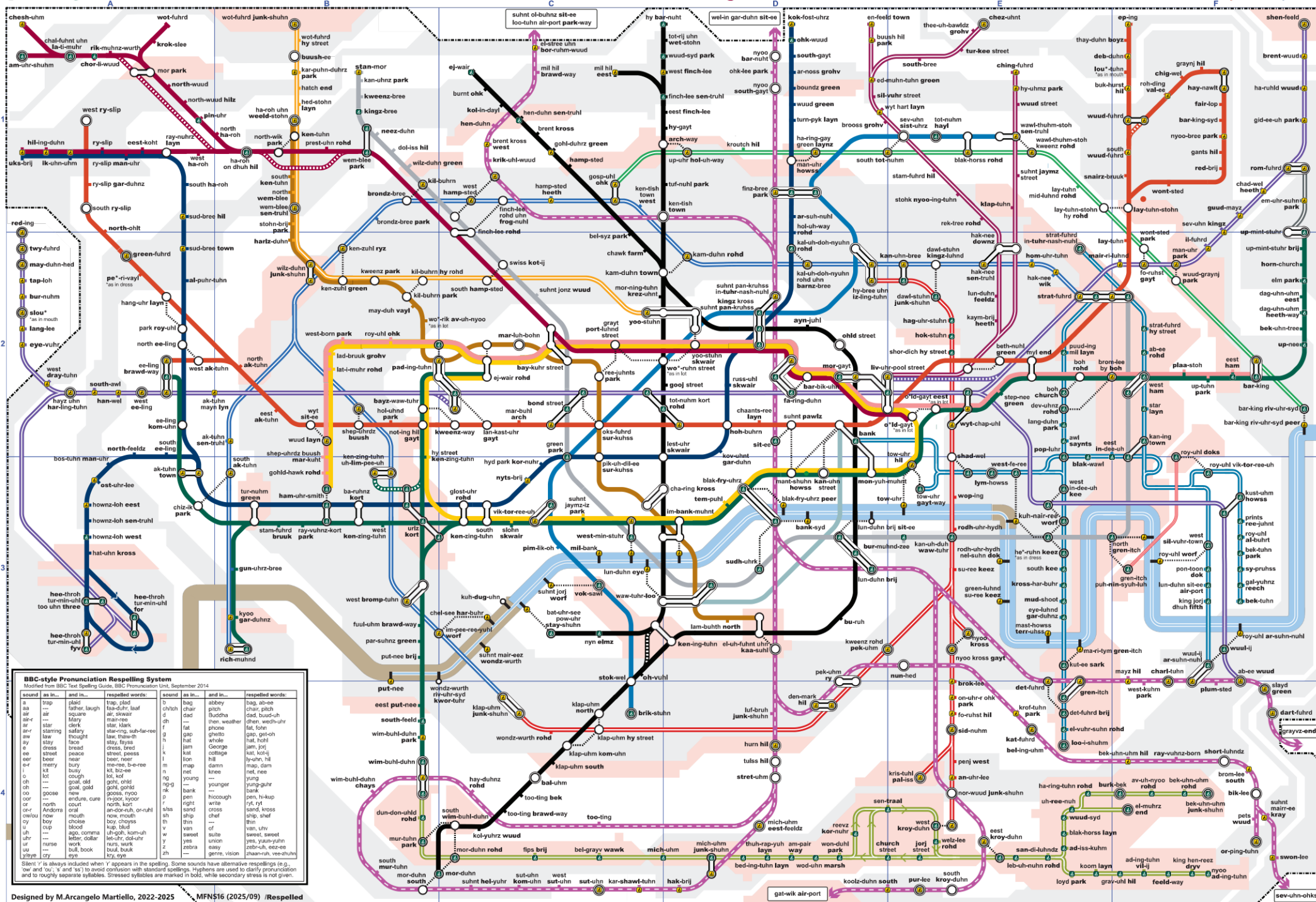

Pronunciation of Tube Stations

English pronunciation can be tricky even for native speakers because English has about 46 phonemes, or basic speech sounds, but there are only 26 letters in the alphabet. To represent these sounds, around 250 common graphemes—letters or combinations of letters—are used. The spelling system is complex, and to make things more difficult, there are many exceptions, such as archaic spellings and foreign words.

-Complex Spelling rules: SSB English has 8 diphthongs which are combinations of two vowel sounds: (ee), (ay), (oy), (y/eye), (ou/ow), (oo), (oh) as in goat, and (oh) as in goal. Each of these diphthongs can be represented by different graphemes. For example, the challenge in *Maida Vale* (mayd-uh **vayl**) is recognising that both <ai> in ~10% of cases, and <a_e> in ~40% of cases can represent the sound (ay). Other common spellings of this diphthong are <a> in ~25% of words as in *Angel* (**ayn**-juhl), and <ay> in ~20% of words as in *Bayswater* (**bayz**-waw-thur). While <aye> as in *Hayes* (hayz), and <ey> as in *Leyton* (**lay**-tuhn) are rare.

-Exceptions: Some of the most unique spellings found only in certain station names include *Greenwich* (**gren**-itch), *Plaistow* (**plaa**-stoh), and *Ruislip* (**ry**-slip). In Mary, the letter <y> functions as a vowel, but in the common pronunciation of *Marylebone* (**mar**-luh-bohn), it is pronounced as though there were no <y> at all. While silent consonants are not uncommon, oddities like the silent <ce> in *Leicester Square* (lest-uh **skwair**) are quite rare. Indeed, exceptions often seem to be the rule in *Loughborough Junction* (luf-bruh **junk**-shuhn), which features many peculiarities, such as <ou> for (u), <gh> for (f), and <ough> for (uh)

BBC Text Respelling

The BBC Pronunciation Unit created this system to help broadcasters correctly pronounce anything they may need to say, including foreign names. It is designed to be easily understood by native English speakers. It is primarily written with the typical spelling for each sound, such as (u) for the strut vowel, with a few additions, like (uh) for the schwa sound. In some cases, such as with the diphthong in the *price* subset, different spellings where <y> or <igh> are used in different environments to avoid confusion with standard spelling.

However, when <y> appears between a consonant and a vowel, it represents a glide. For example, beauty is transcribed as byoo-tee. The historical r is always included, whether or not it is pronounced, depending on the speaker's accent.

Syllables with primary stress are indicated with a bolder font. The way words are broken into syllables is not meant to reflect actual syllabification but rather to ensure the most intuitive transcription. When a vowel is long, the following consonant is placed after the hyphen, for example *Peter* is transcribed as **pee**-tuh. When a vowel is short, the consonant goes immediately after the vowel, before the hyphen; for example *Jenny* is transcribed as **jen**-ee).
